Club of the Month

Ivanhoe Club, Lake County, Illinois

The Ivanhoe Club is an exclusive, nationally recognized country club located in the center of Lake County, Illinois, approximately 45 miles from downtown Chicago. Situated within the 400-acre property are twentyseven holes, an extensive practice facility including a 1-acre short game area and a 67,000 square foot clubhouse with tennis and swimming facilities.

Each nine offers Ivanhoe's member with three distinctive styles. The Forest nine is routed along pristine lakes and across rolling hills lined with mature Oak trees. Waves of native grass blanketing gently rolling hillocks gives the Prairie nine its character, which

can be likened to the links found on the British Isles. The Marsh nine is home to a variety of wildlife including herons, red winged blackbirds, terns and turtles that all make the wetlands their home. This beautiful wetland also provides for nine strategic, challenging golf holes.

In 1998, the nationally recognized golf course architectural firm of Arthur Hills/Steve Forrest and Associates was retained to transform all three nines into a cohesive twenty-seven-hole facility that would provide for a Top 100 golf course experience. The construction on the third nine was completed in the fall of 2003, and the complete golf course was unveiled in June of 2004.
