



As golf course settings go, few can match the magnificence of Oitavos. The course nestles among the sand dunes and pine trees of the Sintra-Cascais Natural Park in a picture perfect location that is framed by a backdrop of ocean on one side and mountains on the other. With such off-course attractions to compete against, most courses would struggle to hold the interest of visitors; not so here, though. Don't be fooled by the birth certificate, Oitavos is a course well beyond its four years, with narrow holes trundling through spectacular landscape that treats golfers to a links experience, complete with hard, fast greens, tight fairways and an ever-present sea breeze.
